Dear Hal:

I've enclosed a couple of the items I've promised, including a copy of the story we did for Monday on your and Wecht's criticism of the Rockefeller (Belin) Commission. As you'll be able to see, I had to keep very short the short interview you gave me on the phone—but I think the point gets across.

In addition to the S.F. Examiner story which is enclosed and details the F.B.I.'s extensive photo work last week on the "Bum pictures", I'm expecting another story(about Rockefeller Commission Rock investigator Robert Olsen talking to Dallas cops) in the mail soon. That stormy, from a Dallas paper, will be copied and sent along to you.

I'M also awaiting that taped interview with Oswald which is being sent from Boston. When I get that, I'll dug a copy and forward it too.

Interest in the assassinations is mounting incredibly. I think Congress is the path of a tidal wave of public interest and potential outrage. I predict a full Congressional probe to be announced within four months. (I'm kew to this field, and I may be wrong — but I don't see how the subject can be suppressed much longer).
