Yes, I knew of Doctors Shaw, Gregory, and Shires' testimony and that Shires said he arrived late but in time to operate on the left leg. Harold - I do personally know of not a few instances where important documents relating to birth, death, and other important medical and surgical events have been done by one person and described and signed by a second person when the second person was not in attendance but instead was out of the hospital, city, county, state, and, yes, even out of this hemisphere!!! So, therefore my informant did not greatly surprise me. However, when I told him of your thorough-going character and that you had not picked up his alleged perjury of Doctor Shires his certainty diminished.

Harold - you seemed surprised when I mentioned Whitewash, Whitewash II, and Oswald in New Orleans could be had in second hand book shops. I have obtained Whitewash in two copies and am sending one to you. Oswald in New Orleans was also obtained, I will keep it. Now, I have all of your work on this except Photographic Whitewash. Will keep in contact with you and soon as something breaks will send advanced copy.
