Moyers, Newsday Split in Campaign

GARDEN CITY, N. Y. (AP) —Newsday, a Long Island newspaper endorsed Richard M. Nixon for president today, but its publisher, former presidential aide Bill D. Moyers, supported Hubert H. Humphrey in a separate statement.

Newsday, politically independent, endorsed Democrats Lyndon B. Johnson in 1964 and John F. Kennedy in 1960. The newspaper's editor and publisher in 1960 was the late Alicia Patterson. Her husband, Harry F. Guggenheim, then Newsday president, endorsed Nixon in a separate column.
