

Subjunctive Pres to grand jury - This is precedent for getting  
him into court, 1807 - Burr - treason - B. number -  
letter Jefferson had. Marshall said Pres. like any -  
one else, clearly subject to be subpoenaed & to go into  
court & testify.

But <sup>North</sup> <sup>commission</sup> - And Pres properly refused to make  
up his <sup>commission</sup> & was <sup>not</sup> subpoenaed - per se. - D.J.  
said he was immune to service. Judge  
Gruen rejected any view of fact he ~~could~~
