Korff Vows 'Curb Media'


BOSTON, Aug. 16 (UPI)-Rabbi Baruch Korff, who was a steadfast supporter of President Nixon through the latter stages of the Watergate affair, says he will "tear the capital apart" in a campaign to impose curbs on the news media.

Korff, chairman of the National Committee for Fairness to the President, which he founded earlier this year, said Thursday the news media had demeaned the presidency in its "persecution" of Mr. Nixon and vowed that his organization will conduct the campaign for restrictions on the press.
