No Change Reported In Nixon's Condition

LONG BEACH, Calif., Sept. 29 (AP) — Former President Nixon wound up his first week in the hospital today with no reported change in his condition since Friday. Mrs. Nixon said Saturday he was feeling much better.

Mr. Nixon's doctor said he would issue the next medical report at midday

Monday.

Dr. John C. Lungren said Friday that Mr. Nixon was responding satisfactorily to the anticoagulant drug therapy he has been receiving since entering Memorial Hospital Medical Center last Monday for treatment of a vein inflammation in his left leg and a small blood clot in his right lung.
