Howard, while listening to Maldeman's opening statement it suddenly occurred to me that long before this, given the Nixon and Nixonite over-emphasis of his great accomplishments for peace, including the SAMT deal, I should have looked into Nixon's position and activity, if any, when JFK's limited test-ban agreement and other steps foward peace and better relations with the USSR were up, when JFK was apprehensive about their prospects, and when Nixon was the leader of the party from which the major opposition stemmed. Does your research include this, without your having to do much work? I don't know if it is in the papers I gave you and don't recall if it is in Schkesinger, Sorensen etc. Sch's index is broken down and I'll go over the Mixon and test-ban entries when I'm at that point.
