Don't Prejudge Agnew - Julie

DETROIT, Oct. 20 (UPI)—Julie Nixon Eisenhower said Friday that people shouldn't prejudge former Vice President Agnew until all the facts are laid on the line.

Mrs. Eisenhower was attending an Adcraft Club luncheon for the Curtis Publishing Co. and one of its magazines, the Saturday Evening Post, where she works as assistant editor.

In response to a newsman's question, she urged the public to have sympathy for Agnew and hold off judging him until they know all the facts.
