The President's voungest daughter, addressing a news conference during the dedication of a \$3.4 million rehabilitation center for the crippled, said:

"I'm preed of my father and I'm sau to see this happen because I teel he's done so much for the country. I think this is hurting the administration. I know he is doing everything in his power to get to the truth in Watergate "
