

Nixon Guard Unit Probed on Drugs

EL TORO, Calif., Oct. 13 (UPI)—The Marine Corps said Friday night members of the elite presidential security unit, who protested the President on trips to the Western White House, have been relieved of duty following an investigation into drug use.

The eight are among 26 military policemen at the Marine Corps air station here relieved of duty, a spokesman said. Thirty-four other marines are under investigation for possible drug violations, the spokesman said.
