Q. I understand that Rabbi Baruch Korff, Richard Nixon's fund-raiser, has been offering Nixon for lectures and TV interviews at \$250,000 per. Have there been any takers? Why does Nixon need so much money?—T. R. R., Arcadia, Calif.

A. According to Rabbi Korff, Nixon has run up some \$300,000 in legal bills in order to keep control of his Presidential tapes and papers. Public contributions as of last month paid about \$145,000 of those bills. No networks have offered Nixon \$250,000 for an interview.
