Q. There is a joke or an anecdote about Moses which Golda Meir, Prime Minister of Israel, usually tells visiting dignitaries. Can you find out which one it is? —Lena Schwartzkopf, Miami, Fla.

A. Golda Meir from time to time has said jokingly of Moses to visiting foreign diplomats: "Moses led our people across the desert for almost forty years, then settled at the one site in the entire Middle East which has no oil."

Q. Is Peter Sellers going to impersonate the President in a play called An Evening With Richard Nixon?—V. Wickers, Baltimore, Md.

A. Such a play was produced on Broadway about a year and a half ago. It was written by Gore Vidal who describes it as "a highly biased political charade." Vidal has rewritten the play, bringing in Watergate, and producer Hillard Elkins is discussing with Peter Sellers the possibility of Sellers playing the lead in London.
