Miss Bussollo referred the booklet written by Mr. William G. Northrup to the Bureau. This booklet has been reviewed, contains no references to the FBI, and Bureau files contain no reference to Northrup.

Mr. Northrup attempted to explain that Oswald's point of aim was Governor Connally; however, due to the angle of the shot and the movement of the car, the shot struck the President. The booklet is being returned as requested and a Xerox copy has been retained for completion of Bureau files.
