Garrison Quiz Lost Witness' Has Lie Test

Washington March 25 (UPI)—Gordon Novel, the "missing witness" in New Orleans district attorney Jim Garrison's investigation of an alleged Kennedy assassination conspiracy, popped up in a Washington suburb today

and took a lie detector test to support his charge that the Garrison investigation was a "fraud."
The operator of the polygraph test, Lloyd Furr of mearby McLean, Va., said Novel "passed" the lie test. "He" showed no deceptions," Furr said.

Novel's Reply to Furr

"Do you honestly believe Garrison's conspiracy prosecution is
a fraud?" Furr said he asked
Novel. "Yes," he said Novel replied. A former New Orleans
night club operator, Novel left
New Orleans shortly before a
grand jury investigating the assassination tried to subpena him.
He is wanted in New Orleans as
a material witness.
