Added atmosphere was contributed there by a late evening radio  
disc-jockey with his anti- Kennedy, anti- civil, anti -human rights  
commentary , such as,; "someones" got to get that Kennedy, etc, etc, etc,"

This was part of the aura of pre-assassination.

Philadelphia's W.P.E.N. radio station on the "Reds Benson", late night  
program hosted an expert on hypnosis and parapsychology several days after  
the assassination. They explored the situation and disputed the then  
current common opinions.

The "false Oswald" Cuban incidents diversion, has been explored
