On 12/6/63, Dellus, Texas, advised that on 11/28/63, she said her sister, war- wisiting in Towarkana, Towas. Sometime between 22 9:5 em: 5:30 PM en 11/28/63, they were driving around, and drove to the Best of Johnson Motel and turned ground, then started driving west on Highway 67, towers Dallas. They atopped at Pecan Jos's, and went in to get something to ast. An employer at Pream Jos's, the only one on duty, was a white femals about 60 years old, 5' 2", 130 ths., gray hair combed up with short curls on top, and this woman storted a conversation with them by mentioning that their auto license indicated they were from Dallas. They talked about the feath o. President KNEEDI, and mentioned that it was her belief that this was God's plan, just as everything that happens is God's plan. This employee then mentioned that several days previously, which was after the depth of President KENTEDY, some "Government man" was in there and mentioned that something was going to come out in a month or two that would show that President REMEMBY had been trying to work something out with a foreign country that would just ruin the United States. This "Government man" did not specify what this was, that he was telking about, and did not specifically say so, but he laft the impression that something good would come out of the President's death, because this deal probably would not be worked out. The woman employee at Pecan Joe's did not talk like she know this Government man. This woman did not specifically day that this Govt. man said that the assessination was a good thing. The said she tought this woman employee at Pecan Jos's wes just engaged in some malicious gossip.
