JFK Probe Requested

Pat O'Daniel, Democratic candidate for governor, Tuesday urged a state investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy.

In a speech to supporters at his Dallas headquarters, the local insurance executive said as governor he would launch such an investigation to find the answers to the many still unanswered questions concerning the late president's death here Nov. 22, 1963.

"This was and still is a state matter," he said. "Certain authorities have deliberately concealed the truth from the people of Texas as well as those of the United States and the world."

O'Daniel, son of former Texas governor and Sentor W. Lee O'Daniel, also renewed the other parts of his program which include opposition to liquor-by-thedrink and support of higher pay for teachers.
