SUBJECT: State Department Files

1. Reference is made to your letter of 24 August 1964, listing certain documents sent to the Department of State by the Central Intelligence Agency and handed to the Commission by the Department, which you state will be placed in the State Department section of the Commission files in a public depository, where they would be available for examination under certain circumstances. The documents are:

- I-55(2) CIA telegram, November 24, 1963, regarding Cuban precautions following assassination of President Kennedy.
- II-6(2) Dispatch transmitted October 11, 1963 (regarding American male, who identified himself as Lee Oswald, who contacted the Soviet Embassy in Mexico City) to Department of State, FBI, and Navy Department.
- III-2(2) Dispatch transmitted October 11, 1963 to Department of State, FBI, and Navy. Duplicate of above, II-6(2).
- XI-2(2) Duplicate of II-6(2) and III-2(2).
- VI-17(2) Memorandum, November 26, 1963 from Joseph Scott, Department of State to A. Chayes, transmitting memorandum of November 26, 1963 from R. Ulbrich. (Duplicate of I-55(2)).
