There is one thing I do point out, have however, and that is his objections, which, depending on the possible publisher might or might not be objected to, can be eliminated in editing and he knows that very well.

He could have told me which of them might be more inclined to go for something like than, without sending it wit there himself, and he didn't.

I've heard nothing from Seven Stories.

The CD-ROM busines, which I know nothing at all about, seems fine and I do appreciate it. However, each should have a notice at the beginning that it is one of a series of unedited rough drafts prepared as a record for history and before any of it is used it should be checked.

I'll be glad to have the suggestions you will make re Waketh but please do thy, hard as it may be, to understand that while I have something to get of paper for the future, this is priority. I'll be glad to read th suggestions and to file the with the manuscripts originals. Including the real stupidity of consfusing Stevenson with Carroll, which I think has been dded.

On Waketh, there are two epilogues. I urge you not to omit the second.

McKnight is a painstakingly careful writer. And a fine one.
