I Got your note last night when I arrived home after work. I spoke to Professor Wrone on Wednesday on the telephone. It seems that the diskette I sent him with your original manuscript pages (I indicated I would "subcontract" the work for him: return all materials to him for his forwarding along with his work to you) did not permit him to print out the whole page that was on his screen. I have spent the last two days trying to troubleshoot the problem and offer a solution. The problem turned out to be that the page was formatted fo print on 8½" inches by 14 inches instead of 11 inches. The pages are normally set up to format/print to 11 inches but they were changes for some reason. I have since worked it out and have printed the enclosures out for you.

I have not paginated the chapters except for two chapters because I don't know what page numbers to start from. When I do I shall repaginate appropriately.

Got to the post office with this bundle (Chapters 9-16) so that you can start your editing. I won't be surprise if chapter 13 is messed up a little since I was reformatting the pages and graphics with no hard copy to work from. So go easy on me when you instruct me as to where the pages format is awry.
