Dear Harold:

I got your letters of the 6/25 and 6/27 in the same envelope today. I will mail this letter on Monday so there will be an explainable gap between writing this one and posting it due to the July 4th holiday. I got your *Oswald in New Orleans* index and photocopied it and sent it back earlier this week(?) Th next day after receiving it. It looked like an original and I did not want to damage it or (God forbid) lose it.

The remarks regarding the card I sent you have left me pleased that it brought you joy. Unlike the many of your admirers which I perceive to be sycophants writing to ingratiate themselves with you, I was being sincere in the message that accompanied the card. You have been an inspiration to many with far less courage than that which you have demonstrated. I recognize that it will only be with your padding that you will receive recognition for your accomplishments.

In my day-to-day passings I am approached by people who make references to alleged assassination conspiracy theories and I am prompted for my theory. The response I give them is what I have learned in your books and manuscripts: the theories you have read in the many assassination conspiracy books are pure bull! Whether they are Anthony Summers-like or Posnerian. I find myself knocking down the theories that others pose using the knowledge I have developed from reading the 26-volume appendices and from our communications. In so doing I am encouraging more and more people to seek out your Whitewash: Report on the Warren Report. Some that I trust will return the copy, I give my Dell version of Whitewash. I am attempting to be in your area during on of the last two weeks in this month if I can swing it. I will keep you informed as soon as it firms up. So much for now.
