In addition to his books on the Warren report which he criticized as not going far enough and in following the government line, Weisberg has a new book about to come out on the New Orleans angle of the Lee Oswald story.

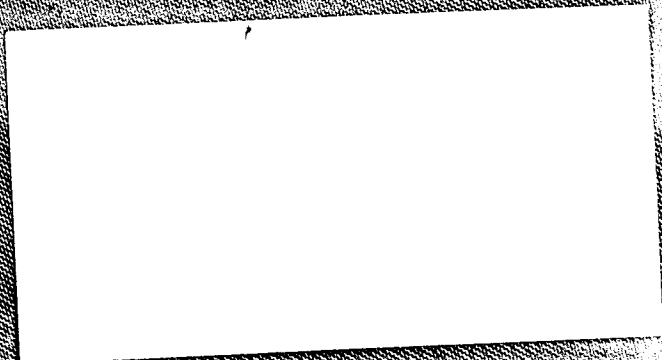
