Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY advised the Bureau was forwarding this PM a copy of a Memorandum pertaining to the RUBY investigation, which is being considered for dissemination to the President.

Report placed on American Airlines Flight 381, c/o Captain C. B. ROE, arriving Dallas Love Field at 10:29 PM. Flight left Washington, D.C. at 6:05 PM. Inspector instructed that flight be met by Agents and accordingly SAS ALTON E. BRAMBLETT and LANSING P. LOGAN were instructed to meet this plane.

Further, Inspector MALLEY advised that the Bureau would inform Dallas sometime this evening as to the necessity of initiating the review and documentation of the RUBY Memorandum immediately following receipt, or whether the review could begin on Monday morning, 12/2/63.

PAT DEERY, General Investigative Division, BOG, at 9:40 PM advised it was permissible to commence the review and documentation of the RUBY Memorandum on Monday morning. It was pointed out that it was not necessary to institute the review for the Dallas Division's observations as to the correctness contained within the Memorandum on late evening 12/1/63 as previously instructed. Accordingly SAS CLEMENTS, THOMPSON and RICE were informed of these instructions. It is noted that they were requested by SAC SRANKLIN to stand by for the Memorandum review if same was necessary.
