MEMORANDUM FOR MR. TOLSON
MR. BOARDMAN
MR. ROSEN
MR. NICHOLS

The Attorney General called to advise that he had received my memorandum of July 8, 1956 concerning Warren Olney's memorandum to this Bureau of the same date regarding Unknown subject; - Peter Weisberger - Victim. The Attorney General indicated that he thought this matter concerning the Bureau's jurisdiction in kidnaping cases had been previously resolved and stated he plans to talk to Olney this morning and he would be in touch with me as to the results.

I told the Attorney General that I was quite concerned with the paper record that was being built up and which in the future could be used to embarrass everyone. I stated Olney was advised that we do not issue press releases; that such are issued by the Department. The Attorney General indicated he would have the above mentioned memorandum from Olney withdrawn and I told him that in the Dammann Case Olney had written a like memorandum and Deputy Attorney General Rogers had had it withdrawn and yet about two months later Olney issued a memorandum to the Bureau referring to the memorandum which supposedly had previously been withdrawn. The Attorney General stated he would let me know the results of conference with Mr. Olney.
