I contacted Group Research about Osanka. They have records on a Franklin Mark Osanka who is listed as the author of an article on "Communist Insurgents" in Freedom's Facts, March, 1969 issue. The article is copyrighted in 1964 and Osanka is described as "One of the few American authorities on communist insurgency and guerilla warfare; has served as a consultant to U. S. for in special warfare. For this article he received the All American Conference Vigilant Patriot Award." Freedom's Facts is a publication of the All American Conference to Combat Communism which lists its publishing address as 1028 Connecticut Ave., Washington, D. C.
