Your 19 October 1987 Freedom of Information Act request, addressed to Keesler $A F B$, was forwarded to this headquarters for consideration. We received your request on 29 October 1987.

A determination has been made that a portion of the documents you requested is releasable under the Freedom of Information Act and are provided free of charge since fees total less than $\$ 15.00$. The only record located for Lee $H$. Oswald is TTAF Form 20, the same document you provided with your request. Therefore, additional copy is not being provided. Records could not be located for Daniel P Powers or Edward J Bandoni. Records for the three remaining individuals are attached. The Act also provides for withholding certain information when release would jeopardize governmental interests. In this respect, identifying characteristics (name, service number, and date of birth) are exempt from disclosure pursuant to the authority contained in 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6) and Air Force Regulation 12-30, paragraph 10f. Release of personal data of living persons without their written consent would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Should you wish to appeal our decision to withhold release of the cited information, you must write to the Secretary of the Air Force within 45 days from the date of this letter. Include in your appeal your reasons for reconsideration and any supporting material deemed appropriate, and attach a copy of this letter. Address your letter to HQ ATC/DADF, Randolph AFB TX 78150-5001. Upon receipt of your appeal we will immediately forward it to the Secretary of the Air Force.
