Ref: Freedom of Information Act Request dated 2 October 1987

Thank you for your letter dated 13 October 1987 in response to the above FOIA request in which you stated that the sought after records have been destroyed.

I have attached hereto a copy of one of the non-existent records which I am requesting and which was obtained in 1977, ten years after such records are supposedly destroyed. I believe this will demonstrate that such policy is not always carried out and therefore assume that a search was not conducted for the documents and or records which I have requested. I believe that you were simply quoting regulations and do not therefore lay the blame at your door.

I expect the Air Force to supply me with copies of the records requested if such do indeed exist and to at least carry out a search to determine if such is the case. I have reason to believe that such records do exist.

Due to the fact that the Government failed to make such records part of the official records (Warren Commission Report) and that such records may well shed further light on this historical event, I would appreciate it if you would be kind enough to waive the normal fees for this request.
