HENRY OMNARD, San Francisco, California, advised HARRY NIER, FPCC leader at University of Colorado, an admitted Marxist, was in contact with a person named OSWALD in Mexico in 1982. NIER in radio interview denied knowledge of OSWALD. DONALD PETER CAMARATA, former MSMC associate of OSWALD, advised that MARTIN E. SCHPAND, USMC, was killed while on sentry duty with OSWALD in Philippine Islands. SCHRAND's death ruled accidental but rumors placed OSWALD as being responsible.
