Oswald's notebook. Earlier refs, exchanges with Paul Hoch

CD 205, 671-701 are the 12/23/63 Cemberling report on Oswald's notebook. The admittedly retyped first page says "Fritz gave it to Hosty 11/27. Here the number is at the top of the left-hand part of the page, on the line above "DL 111-10461, under which is "JTK;gmf; wam". Note these do not include Cemberling's initials and he and Hoover says this is his report.

The only other page with the number at the upper left is 25, on which, as Paul says, Hosty's name should have appeared.

The other pages have the number centered at the bottom, each flanked by a space and a hyphen.

The first two pages have "CE" written in at the bottom but, of course, no numbers.

CD 385 is entitled, "E. SUBJECT'S MEXICO ADDRESS BOOK". The pages are stamped 278 through 283. Here all the pages have their original pagination in the upper left-hand corner, under the identification "DL 100-10461". The initials on the first page are "ELH:GJ" or "GG". This is unclear. Neither report makes any reference to Leads. This second report does not contain Kessler's identification.

Dates are 12/23/63 and 2/1/64, rather wide spread, especially for such vital evidence and with so little remaining, but five pages.
