1. Information from our Dallas office provides names of several persons connected with Ruby and Oswald. [redacted], contacted resident Agent Dallas about 1330 CST yesterday and said he had information in regard assassination of President Kennedy. [redacted] said he and one [redacted] operated [redacted] Dallas. About two weeks ago, Jack Ruby/aka/Rubenstein and subject Oswald visited [redacted] and wanted work done on microphones at Ruby Carousel Night Club, Dallas. On this occasion Ruby told Oswald to write names of [redacted] and [redacted] in Carousel guest book. [redacted] did the requested mike work at the Carousel and were paid by Negro employee. The Senior Resident Agent at Dallas has taken to the FBI Dallas for further interrogation. Neither [redacted] nor [redacted] has discussed above information with anyone else, according to [redacted]. The files at DIO 811D are negative on [redacted].

2. In this office we have a file on [redacted]

This morning we had a meeting here to make sure that everybody is informed and that the FBI is getting everything it needs.

3. The above information certainly raises questions as to Ruby's real motives in killing Oswald. We have all been interested in what seemed to us to be a look of recognition on Oswald's face when he spotted Ruby.

4. BuPers is being kept currently informed of information of the sort contained in paragraphs 1 and 2 above.

Miss Frances Weaver, employed in 1-5 was a witness to the above incident. All entrances to the Fairmont Building were immediately secured.

MEMO FOR RECORD

1. FOLLOWING INFO REC'D 1710R FROM CAPT. JACKSON, (OP-921);

LEE HARVEY OSWALD, DOB 18 OCT 39, NEW ORLEANS, LA.

ONE-HALF HOUR AFTER PRES. WAS SHOT OSWALD WAS STOPPED IN DALLAS BY TWO POLICEMEN, OSWALD SHOT AND KILLED ONE POLICEMAN AND WAS CAPTURED BY THE OTHER POLICEMAN. OSWALD WORKS IN THE BUILDING (TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY, 411 M^{ST.}, DALLAS) THE BUILDING FROM WHICH (6th FLOOR) THE PRES WAS SHOT. FIVE PEOPLE HAVE IDENTIFIED OSWALD AS BEING IN THE BUILDING AT THE TIME OF THE SHOOTING. THE RIFLE USED WAS FOUND ON A BACK STAIRWAY IN THIS BUILDING. IT IS OF ITALIAN MANUFACTURE.

OSWALD WENT TO RUSSIA ABOUT 3 YEARS AGO AND TRIED TO RENOUNCE HIS U.S. CITIZENSHIP. HE WAS DISCHARGED FROM THE USMC BECAUSE OF THIS TRIP. OSWALD HAS A HALF BROTHER NAMED EDWARD J. PICK WHO IS SAID TO BE WILD AND CRAZY, HIS CONNECTION WITH THE CRIME IS UNKNOWN AT PRESENT. SEE ATTACHED CIA MSG 102012Z OCT 63.


1. Keep an alert watch on the telephone. Since the bell does not ring this is mandatory.
