

Dear Sir:

I'm writing you because you seem to be one of the few Americans who still wishes to learn the truth about Lee Harvey Oswald's guilt or innocence.

I believe Oswald took this evidence right to the grave with him. In all the books and articles printed about this case I have never read anything about the following.

Since a few hours after his arrest it has always been my belief that his shoulder should have been examined for scuffing.
