Reference is made to a letter from this Bureau dated June 3, 1960, advising that subject, who had renounced his American citizenship at the United States Embassy, Moscow, Russia, on October 31, 1959, was expected to enter the Albert Russia, on October 31, 1959, was expected to enter the Albert Schweitzer College in Switzerland on April 20, 1960,

Subsequent information received from a confidential source abroad indicates that subject never arrived at the above-named College, although he had paid a \$25 deposit toward school fees. The College has not heard from subject since he sent this deposit in June, 1959, from an unknown address.
