Mr. CECIL BALES, Kyle, Texas, was interviewed and furnished the following information:

At approximately 6:30 P.M., November 23, 1963, three boys and one girl had entered his store in Kyle, Texas, and wanted to watch his television as they had been hunting near New Braunfels, Texas, and had just heard about the assassination. As they were watching the television, the girl asked BALES if they had caught the person who had done the killing. Mr. BALES remarked that the police had a suspect from Fort Worth, Texas, who was supposed to be a member of the Fair Play for Cuba Organization. The girl then remarked that it sounded like a person she had known in Fort Worth by the name of OSWALD. Mr. BALES stated he told the girl that was the name of the person who the police were holding, and the girl then remarked that she did not think that OSWALD had enough guts to do a thing like this. Another boy also mentioned that he knew this OSWALD and had seen him in Fort Worth passing out literature for the Fair Play for Cuba Organization. Another boy said he was the son of former Vice President JOHN NANCE GARNER's daughter. All four said they were students at the University of Texas.
