

Oswald's change-of-address cards 11/29/68 HW

Perhaps misled by Liebeler's comment he would just add one to "the stack",, also in order to obtain samples of the known writing of LHO, I have been getting his change of address cards, not as simple a procedure as might be anticipated.

The simplest explanation, which may or may not be true, did not occur to Liebeler or Holmes. It is that of Tenkersley, a postal clerk in New Orleans, who told Garrison's office he had filed the form out and sent it to Dallas because they were still getting mail forwarded from Dallas that then had to be sent back to Dallas
