There are enclosed two copies of a memorandum dated May 6, 1964, concerning records of the Mexican Immigration Department pertaining to individuals who, traveling on other than Mexican FM-5 or FM-8 Tourist Permits, entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo on September 26, 1963, and departed therefrom on October 3, 1963. #965

We are endeavoring to obtain copies of the FM-11 forms referred to in the enclosed memorandum and same will be furnished to you when received. In light of our findings concerning the travel of Lee Harvey Oswald from Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, to Mexico, D. F., on September 26 and 27, 1963, via the Flecha Roja bus line and his return to Nuevo Laredo on October 3, 1963, via the Transportes del Norte bus line, we do not intend to extend our inquiry to include efforts to locate and interview all individuals who entered Mexico and departed therefrom at Nuevo Laredo on the indicated dates. We are continuing inquiry in an effort to interview those individuals who traveled on the buses on which Oswald was a passenger.
