Mr. ABE PEKOVAR, apartment 71, Lake Terrace Gardens, Paris Avenue, advised that he operated the Dolly Shoe Company at 729 Canal Street during the period February, 1955, into some time in 1957, the exact date he does not recall. Mr. PEKOVAR advised that at this time he does not have any records of the employees of this company and that he himself does not recall having an individual named LEE HARVEY OSWALD working for him. He advised that the people who were employed for him were adults as most of them were in the sales capacity and he would not hire individuals in their teens for this particular job.

Mr. PEKOVAR pointed out that perhaps prior employment records could be checked with his accountant, MOSE BRENER, located in the Maison Blanche building, New Orleans, and further that perhaps his former manager, MAURY GOODMAN, now located with Allen Shoe Store on Canal Street, may be able to advise as to whether or not OSWALD had been employed by the Dolly Shoe Store during the period 1955-1956.
