Oswald Exhumation

FORT WORTH, Tex.—A state judge heard over an hour's testimony in the dispute over whether the body buried in Lee Harvey Oswald's grave should be exhumed, then adjourned to consider the case.

Judge James F. Wright gave no indication when he would rule on whether the Fort Worth burial site should be opened to check the identity of the remains.

The Warren Commission reported Oswald was the lone assassin of President Kennedy in November 1963, but controversy over the finding continues. A British author who believes a Soviet agent was substituted for Oswald wants the body in the Fort Worth grave exhumed and examined.
