Marina Oswald Porter's attorney, Jerry Pittman, says he will file a petition this week seeking to open the grave of Lee Harvey Oswald, the accused assassin of President John F. Kennedy.

Robert Oswald, brother of the accused assassin, has blocked earlier exhumation attempts. Pittman said yesterday in a telephone interview that his client is "a little bit disturbed. She thought her proposal was reasonable."

Pittman said Sunday he will file the petition "no sooner than Wednesday and hopefully no later than Friday" in the Tarrant County District Clerk's office.

Robert Oswald's attorney, Craig Fowler, maintains his client is "still against it. He's satisfied that his brother is there and always has been, and is against disturbing the grave on general principles." 8/1/81
