

On September 8 and 9, 1964, the following Special Agents of the New Orleans Office of the FBI contacted the following individuals at inexpensive hotels located in the vicinity of the Continental Trailways Bus Depot, 1314 Tulane Avenue, New Orleans; the Greyhound Bus Depot, 1710 Tulane Avenue, and the Lafayette Square Branch of the U. S. Post Office, 610 South Street, New Orleans, Louisiana. These individuals advised, according to the hotel registers, no individual by the name of LEE HARVEY OSWALD had stayed at their respective hotels on the night of September 24, 1963. A photograph of OSWALD was shown to these individuals who advised that they had never observed OSWALD at their hotels.
