He stated Mrs. SPINGLER asked him what kind of a car was parked a few cers down from the area of the flag pole, where he was then attending.

He said he told Mrs. SPINSIER the car in question was a Chevrolet. He said he recalled it to be about a 1955 to 1957 model Chevrolet with a light field blue top and a dark, possibly blue, betters. He stated he did not observe any one in the car at the time, and in fact, he did not have a full view of the car because of the other cars parked there.
