But one of the obvious things missing is how the report from Ruth Beck reached the FBI. And, it is typical of a False Oswald setup. These two stations are close to LHO's address. I suspect there is a typo in the Wynn-Dixie address, that it is 490+ Prytania, which parallels Magazine and is close, I've forgotten how close. There was much rumor in that general area, some without doubt false, some checked inadequately, and what is no less troubling, some not checked at all. I am keeping, filing under False Oswald, N.O.

She said that she was under the impression that they received this mail erroneously and have been willing to give it to the mailman. She stated that she had never seen this individual before
