Thank you for your letter dated 13 October 1987 in response to the above FOIA request inwhich you stated that the sought after records have been destroyed.

I have attached hereto eneopy of one of the non-existant records which I am requesting and which was obtained in 1977, ten years after such records are supposedly destroyed. I believe this will demonstrate that such policy is not always carried out and therefore assume that a search was not conducted for the documents and or records which I have requested. I believe that you were simply quoting regulations and do not therefore lay the blame at your door.

I expect the Air Force to supply me with copies of the records requested if such do indeed exist and to atleast carrier out a search to determine if such is the case. I have reason to believe that such records do exist.

Due to the fact that the Government failed to make such records apart of the official records (Warmen Commission Report) and that such records may well shed futher light on this historical event, I would appreciate it if you would be kind enough to waive the normal fees for this request.

This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request. We received your request on 6 October 1987.

Training records are maintained in accordance with the Federal Records Act (44 U.S.C 3101 - 3107 and 3301 - 3314) as promulgated by AFM 12-50, Disposition of Air Force Documentation. Prior to Change 16, 18 July 1977, to AFM 12-50, individual training records for formal courses of instruction were maintained for only 10 years and then destroyed. Therefore, training records for the individuals identified in your letter no longer exist.

The fee for this request has been waived.
