Oswald Wrote of Hate for U. S.

When accused assassin Lee Harvey Oswald went to the Soviet Union in 1959, he wrote his brother Robert, "I will never return to the United States which is a country I hate."

The letter was dated Nov. 9, 1959, just over four years before the day Oswald was accused of assassinating President John F. Kennedy in Dallas. The letter was auctioned for \$750 last week by Charles Hamilton Galleries. A medical researcher was the purchaser.

The letter was part of a collection of Oswald's personal papers. Using notebook paper and purple ink, Oswald wrote to his brother: "You really don't know anything about me."

The letter, filled with errors in punctuation and underscores of important passages, concluded with a half-hearted request for money. "If you want to send me money that I can use, but I do not expect to be able to pay it back."
