Of late, because the local post office says virtually all distant mail is now going by air (and because I'm running out of sirmail stamps) I've been using straight postage. If this has slowed things down, please let me know and I'll return to the use of air mail. I'll be able to get more stamps in a few days.

In the course of refiling some papers, I find CD75: 763 (pœ sibly 703), or page 220 of the appendix to Oswald in New Orleans. It refers to Bringuier having one of Oswald's pamphlets. I note it gives no return address. Do you suppose this one also said 544? Have you checked it?
