CORE, III, residence - 3022 St. Charles Avenue, advised SA JAMES ROYCE PECK that the only person he could think of who might possibly be able to identify persons represented in photographs taken on 8/16/63 at the International Trade Mart, New Orleans, La., by photographers of television station WDSU, was a friend of his whose last name was DANENHOWER who worked in the International Trade Mart, Rental Office, Room M-14.
