Dear Alan,

As I promised when we spoke, here are those Secret Service reports I now have on their interview with Mrs. John Tersikes and her observations. There should be more in the files. I haven't dug it out yet. If and when I do, I'll send it to you automatically.

It is possible they Tersikeses may have seen the New Orleans report, stemped "703". This is what the Secret Service calls its "control number". For reasons beving no connection with Mrs. Tarsikes and her observations and opinions, this was printed in the supplemental volumes, where it is Exhibit 1153, beginning on Page 187 of Volume 22. There is it illegible. The copy herewith is only slightly better. I can bring these things out a little by conscious overexposure on a 5M machine. I doubt if she or her husband have seen the one by Benavides. It was not printed. With all those thousands of pages, where the re is so much tresh, leaving such information out of evidence and history does not encourage belief in the innocence of the inquiry.

If there is any way you can help with this, it will be appreciated. The confusion between the networks we have discussed. It would be good to see if Mrs. Tereites recells she was looking at your effiliate. In fact, I think one of the best things would be to let her read these reports and make any comment she'd like. If you could tape it for me, fine. Any comment she might have to make could be valuable. Sometimes it is but a single word that of fers a real clue.

If there is any way in which she can expend the information in these reprts, that, too, would be helpful. If she recells enything that was omitted (unfortunately, not an uncommon practise), it might very well have significance.

I mm looking forward to hearing from you soon. While for the moment I think it would be better were there no publicity, perhaps we might all get on the phone tegether and you could have it in the can for when publicity might not adversely effect the discovery of what did happen. When I am in New Orleans, which I enticipate will be shortly before the striel, maybe I can fly ever.
