Lieutenant Colonel JAMES "JEFF" POINDEXTER, U. S. Marine Corps, retired, 1541 East 19th Street, Santa Ana, California, advised SA PHILIP P. HANLON on 4/16/64 that he was Commanding Officer of MACS-9 from 2/27/59 until 10/31/59. To his knowledge, there was no investigation by the Marine Corps after OSWALD left the Corps in September, 1959, and went immediately to the Soviet Union. He has no information, nor does he recall that any enlisted men were interviewed about OSWALD prior to his leaving MACS-9 on 10/31/59. OSWALD was unknown to him.

Investigation at Santa Ana and El Toro negative as to the whereabouts of Lieutenant Colonel WILEY HAVERLY.
