Post Uffice Box 30001 was rented to L. H. Osvald on June 3, 1963 at the Lafayette Square Station of New Orleans post office. Home address was shown as 657 French St., New Orleans, but there is no such number on that street. The application listed other persons to receive mail in that box as: A. J. Bidell and Marina Osvald.

Under date of September 24, 1963, Form 3575 was mailed to the post office .. requesting that mail be forwarded to 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas. Box was closed September 26, 1963.

Two copies of a newspaper called the MILITANY were found on hand tonight.

LES H. OSMALD rented a furnished spartment at 4905 Magazine, New Orleans, but his sail case addressed 4907 Magazine St. This was an error apparently as 4907 is the front sportment and 4905 is the side sportment at this address.

> The carrier for the address stated be had never seen anyone in the partment b - remembered handling mail and says it was mostly foreign newspapers. Carrier said he received an order to forward all mail to the box.

JESSE VARUER, Apartment 4911, is the manager of these apartments and collects the rent. He says that Osvald was home most of the time and did not appear to have a job. He stated Mrs. Oswald was a foreigner and could not speak English.

Mrs. Osvald became pregnent and another woman driving a station wagon with " Texas license plates picked her up to drive her to Dallas. She never came back and her husband left a short time later.

The woman driving the station vegon may have been Mrs. Payne but no one in New Orleans interviewed was femiliar with the name PAYNE or MICHAEL PAYNE.


The police have no local record on MICHAEL R. PAYME.
