Because this film is so much clearer than any other copies " have seen or them the copy of the spliced version of all three sequences permitted me by MDSU, I do hope you will arrange to have it symilable for others who may wish to examine it. and I do thank you for this partial compliance with my request.

The FSI report I cited to you also refers to certain still rictures made available to the Secret Service at that time. This is confirmed by the STEU photographer, who still recalls this. As I have written you serlier, only some of these still pictures are in the Harren Commission files at the Archives. They should all be there, available to everyone.

Because response to my letter took elmost two months, may I sak that, prior to having these stills or copies of them transferred, you permit me to examine them in your offices? This will take but a few moments. If I want any copies and if you or the archives would then require written permission from MDCU, I would have time to get this while the transfer is being eccomplished. I plan no publication for any of these pictures. If I did, the MDCU permissionate me would require their written essent, in any event. Their permission, the conditions under which they supplied a copy of what remains in their files, is for study only and that is my only present purpose.

The identification of the 40-seconds of film you supplied goes into my chief interest. It says, specifically, that there were two men helping baseld. To the best of my knowledge, the subsequent FBI investigation eisclosed the neme of but a single one. If the Secret Service, which, I regret, was inhibited in its few Orleans work almost immediately, can shed any light on this, I would welcome it. At the same time, I have done my own investigating, have spoken to those your agents were precluded from interviewing (I select this word with cere), and, if your have continuing interest, will be happy to let you know what have learned and the confirmation I have developed. Two of these interviews are tape recorded, with the permission of those interviewed. If you are interested, you may mear and/or copy this tape, with the sole restriction preservation of my rights and confidence. I have in my files proof this was once an area of great interest to you.
