A vast collection of publications and memorabilia related to the assassination of John F. Kennedy has been donated to Texas Christian University, a university spokesman said yesterday. The collection, which belonged to the late Marguerite Oswald, mother of Lee Harvey Oswald, contains Mrs. Oswald's personal copy of the Warren Commission report annotated in her hand, as well as several letters from her son. Mrs. Oswald died last January.

The collection contains more than 200 hardbound books on the assassination, some autographed by their authors, newspaper and magazine clippings, voice recordings and personal mementos.

"This is a subject very popular with young people," university librarian Dr. Paul Parham said. "Most of the students now attending TCU were in diapers or were born in the year of the assassination, but they're still very interested in it. It's not a subject that dies, apparently."
